

System requirements for Masterfont's Hebrew fonts

Please note that Hebrew fonts require right to left support both by the operating system and the application.

Macintosh

- * recommended: MacOS X 10.3 and later (any language version) with Hebrew language support enabled.
- * MacOS 8.5 or 9 with Hebrew language kit installed.

- Adobe Middle East products: InDesign 2.0.x ME, Photoshop 7.0 ME
OpenType Pro fonts with Nikud (vowels) are supported only by InDesign CS2 ME.

Windows

- * recommended: Microsoft Windows 2000, XP and later (any language version), with Hebrew language support enabled (included in the system but must be enabled)
- * special "MFX" fonts can be used on Microsoft Windows 95, 98, ME and NT

- * Microsoft Office applications 2000 and later (2003 and later recommended), including Microsoft Word, Microsoft Publisher, Microsoft PowerPoint (any language version)
- Adobe Middle East products: InDesign 2.0.x ME, Photoshop 7.0 ME
OpenType Pro fonts with Nikud (vowels) are supported only by MS Office and InDesign CS2 ME.
- * Macromedia Freehand (Hebrew)
- CorelDRAW! 10 and later ((Hebrew)

Mirror fonts to be used in no right to left environment, where Hebrew is not available. These fonts are symbol fonts which mapped to the Latin keyboard and are typed in a mirrored text block to be read from right to left. Used for short text strings only.
